C/CAG staff routinely attends meetings hosted by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and receives information distributed by the MTC pertaining to Federal funding, project delivery, and other regional policies that may affect local agencies. Attached to this report includes relevant information from MTC.

- <u>Calls for Projects</u> The following is a listing of program "calls for projects" that are either currently advertised or that will be advertised in the near future:
 - Lifeline Transportation Program \$2.4 mil for primarily transit related projects that serve low income populations. Call administered by C/CAG and estimated in late October.
 Application deadline is December 5, 2014, at 5:00 p.m.
 - Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 Pedestrian and Bicycle Program \$1.5 mil for pedestrian and bicycle improvement projects. Application deadline is January 12, 2015, at 5:00 p.m.
 - o Priority Development Area (PDA) Parking Policy Technical Assistance Program \$342,000 of technical support to complete planning projects that facilitate the implementation of

parking management strategies supportive of the local vision for growth and development in PDAs. Application deadline is December 1, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.

- 2015 MTC delivery plan Attached is the MTC is delivery plan for FHWA-administered funds in the FFY 2014/15. A request for review was emailed in July to all agencies in San Mateo County who have projects in the FFY 2014/15. Most of the listed projects are OBAG projects and a few are safety program projects. Any projects that are listed in FFY 2014-15, that miss the delivery deadline (Jan 2015) may be penalized.

Risk Based Invoicing

Caltrans has adopted a new invoice procedure statewide. Effective October 1, 2014, all agencies are required to fill out the checklist in its entirety accompanied by a billing summary when submitting invoices to the District for processing.

RE: Proposed FFY 2014-15 STP/CMAQ, STIP and Local Safety Funds Obligation Plan

Caltrans requires that MTC submit an annual obligation plan that includes all FHWA-administered formula-funded projects in the region that are expected to receive an obligation each fiscal year. Due to continued scrutiny of inactive obligations, as well as MTC's need to fully utilize its obligation authority, local agencies whose projects are on the obligation plan are required to submit a complete and accurate Request for Authorization (RFA) to Caltrans District 4 local assistance by November 1, 2014, and receive their obligation by January 31, 2015. Funds not obligated by January 31 are subject to de-programming.

Attached are the proposed obligation plans for FFY 2014-15. They include all projects that have STP/CMAQ funds currently programmed in FY 2014-15 in addition to other projects. Sponsors should review the list and ensure they will be able to submit the RFA (E-76 request) by November 1, 2014, and have the funds obligated by January 31, 2015.
