The City/County Association of Governments (C/CAG) currently has a vacancy on its Airport Land Use Committee (ALUC) for an Aviation Representative. C/CAG is the designated Airport Land Use Commission for San Mateo County. The Airport Land Use Commission provides for the orderly development in the environs surrounding airports and also protects the viability and future operation of the airports. 

Applicants must have an aviation background and reside in San Mateo County. The letter of interest should include the reasons why the applicant wishes to be appointed and any particular experience, background or qualities that they feel would bring value to the Airport Land Use Committee. All letters of interest will be considered by the C/CAG Board of Directors.

The ALUC advises and recommends actions to the C/CAG Board regarding the development and implementation of the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans and other airport land use compatibility issues affecting the three airports in the County. The ALUC consists of 13 members representing 10 cities, the County of San Mateo and the Aviation Community (two representatives). The ALUC meets on the 4th Thursday of each month from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in Burlingame City Hall. There is one vacancy on the ALUC for an Aviation Representative.
