Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee Call for Applicants

The City/County Association of Governments (C/CAG) of San Mateo County has one vacant seat for a Public Member on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) to complete a two-year term which extends from February 2015 to December 2017. The BPAC also has one vacant seat for an elected official. Elected officials remain eligible to serve on the BPAC during the term of their elected office. The BPAC provides advice and recommendations to the C/CAG Board of Directors on all matters relating to bicycle and pedestrian facilities planning and on the selection of projects for regional, state, and federal funding. The BPAC is composed of fifteen (15) members, eight of whom are elected officials and seven of whom are members of the public.

Public member appointments are for a term of two years. Each BPAC Public Member may serve a maximum of three two-year terms, if reappointed by the C/CAG Board. The C/CAG Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee meets on the fourth Thursday of the month at 7:00 p.m. at San Mateo City Hall. Members appointed to fill a vacant term will serve the remaining portion of the original two-year term.

Interested parties should complete and submit answers to the questions on the BPAC Membership Application by January 1, 2016. The Application Form is available at the C/CAG website. Qualified applicants will be invited to briefly address the C/CAG Board at the January 14, 2016 meeting where the Board will vote to select appointees.
