Options for San Mateo County Sub-Region

- Undertake a full sub-region effort
 Develop methodology, distribute the sub-region
 RHNA among San Mateo County jurisdictions
 and comply with all requirements
 (estimated 500-700 hours with more meetings)
- Form a sub-region but rely on ABAG/MTC methodology and allocation of RHNA Rely on ABAG/MTC to develop the methodology and allocate the RHNA among San Mateo County jurisdictions (estimated 150-200 hours with fewer meetings)
- Do not form a sub-region and rely on individual jurisdictions, 21 Elements and Home for All, etc.

Key Considerations


- RHNA is anticipated to be much higher (50% to 200%+ possible based on other regions)
- Limited desire on the part of jurisdictions to enter into "trades" that will result in higher numbers
- Fewer housing sites can be counted
- Land use changes will likely be needed
- Sense of urgency (lots to do)
- Importance of on-time housing element certification by HCD (December 2022)

Key Dates and Other Considerations

- Schedule. Sub-regions must be formed by February 2020. Most of the sub-region work will be done between May 2020 and July 2021.
- Participation. Not all jurisdictions must participate — BUT — participating jurisdictions must be contiguous and must include the unincorporated County.
- Restrictions on Methodology and RHNA Trading. Methodology must <u>further</u> state objectives and comply with "fair housing," etc.
- Opt-Back Option. Sub-region may opt back into the ABAG process at any time.

- Encourage countywide collaboration (21 Elements, Home for All, etc.)

- Encourage jurisdictions to undertake analysis of housing sites NOW
