COVID 19 Pandemic

- Crisis has significant near and long term negative effects on the social and economic well-being of the County, Region, State, and Nation.
- MTC estimates a \$4.6 billion reduction in state and local revenues for transportation through summer of 2021.



Economic Stimulus

- ➤ To date, legislation has focused on emergency/disaster relief.
- The proposed HEROES ACT is a reflection of this with an investment in transit operations, highway funds, and assistance for local governments.
- After disaster relief, legislators will begin working on economic stimulus legislation to strengthen the economy.



C/CAG Preparation

- County Transportation Agencies like C/CAG are beginning to prepare lists of potential projects.
- Economic stimulus efforts typically focus on projects that are ready for construction. (Have environmental, complete design, and complete right of way acquisition).
- C/CAG has started process of compiling lists of projects that can start construction within a reasonable timeframe.



MTC's Policy Recommendation

- ► MTC is advocating for formula based funding rather than specific project earmarks.
- #1. Keeping projects on track.
- #2. Alignment with Plan Bay Area (improving equity and resilience).
- #3. Support job creation by supporting projects that can begin construction within a reasonable timeframe.
- > Staff is working with MTC staff to identify representative construction ready projects.



C/CAG Process

- C/CAG has identified four major categories of projects.
- #1. Countywide Roadway/Bike/Pedestrian projects that were included in the recently adopted PBA 2050 project list.
- #2. \$22m in pavement management funds for all jurisdictions in County.
- #3. Other Bike/and Pedestrian projects.
- #4. Regional Flood Control Water Quality projects.



Draft Project Lists

- > Staff report included 36 projects as starting point.
- ➤ Total cost of \$1.6b. Note: Total cost is not the stimulus request.
- Staff are working with project sponsors to update the list.



Draft Project Lists

- List is focused on projects related to C/CAG mission. It is not intended to include every municipal project in the County.
- Some projects are not shovel ready.
- If the infrastructure legislation is formula based rather than project based, project lists will be utilized for representative purposes.



Next Steps

- Continue to work with project sponsors to refine project lists.
- Explore possibility of adding "electric vehicle infrastructure" to project category.
- ▷ Assist MTC with identifying representative projects.
- Discuss process at C/CAG CMEQ and TAC meetings, and back to Board on 6/11.
- ▶ Prepare letter from C/CAG to Federal representatives.
 The timing will depend on the legislative schedule.
