

What is SMCWPP?

- San Mateo Countywide Water Pollution Prevention Program
- Funded by property tax and vehicle license funds
- Support member agencies in meeting stormwater regulatory requirements from the State
 - Do compliance directly for member agencies
 - Support local program implementation
 - Participate in regional compliance efforts

 - Three corporation yard trainings

 - —Pollutants of concern monitoring (San Carlos)
 - —PCBs and mercury opportunity area analysis
 - Regional monitoring program



- Pesticide Toxicity Control
 - —Point-of-Purchase outreach & trainings (22 stores)
 - —Outreach to pest control operators
 - Regional and statewide participation (grants and regulatory)

- Trash Load Reduction
 - —Long-term plan updates
 - Pilot trash assessment strategy (On-land visual assessments, database, staff training)
 - Litter workgroup (stormwater and solid waste connection)
 - Regional grant participation





- Mercury & PCBs
 - —Source Identification Pilot Project
 - —Pilot studies: data review/reporting
 - Enhanced O&M
 - Treatment retrofit
 - Diversion to sanitary sewer
 - —Permit reissuance negotiations/support



- Rain Barrel Rebate Program
 - C/CAG provides \$50 per barrel countywide
 - Water agencies choose to participate
 - 328 rain barrels installed in San Mateo County
 - Twice as many installed where water agencies partner
 - Over 100 barrels in Alameda & Santa Clara Counties



- Laurel Elementary Demonstration Project
 - Integrates stormwater and Safe Routes to School
 - Partnership with City of San Mateo and San Mateo/Foster City School District

MRP 2.0


- Main Concerns
 - Green Infrastructure Plans
 - —Transition "grey" to "green" infrastructure over decades
 - Trash Load Reduction
 - -70% Reduction by 2017, maybe 90% by 2019
 - PCB Load Reduction
 - Numerical load reductions mandated
 - —Green infrastructure, building materials, property referral
 - —Significant uncertainty in ability to comply



MRP 2.0

- Revised draft likely out next week
- No written comments, oral testimony only
- Adoption at November 18 Water Board hearing
- Last chance to influence Board decision
- Strongly urge elected official participation
- Staff will provide guidance and talking points
