# What is the CMP?



- ▷ Congestion Management Program (CMP) identifies strategies to respond to future transportation needs, monitors congestion, develop procedures to alleviate and control congestion, and promote countywide solutions.
- ▷ Required to measure the roadway segments and intersections on the CMP roadway network to determine the change in Level of Service (LOS)
- ▷ Updated every two years




# CMP Roadway Network


- ▷ 16 Signalized Intersections
  - 8 along ECR
  - 3 along Bayfront Expressway
  - 2 in Daly City and Brisbane
  - 2 in Half Moon Bay
  - 1 in Redwood City
- ▷ 53 Roadway Segments
  
- ▷ New for 2019, Pedestrian and Bicycle Counts performed at the 16 CMP Signalized Intersections in April 2019
  
- ▷ Vehicle turning movement counts typically done during the AM (7-9am) and PM (4-6pm) peak hours




# Pedestrian Counts - AM




# Bicycle Counts - AM
