Program Overview

- Joint TA & C/CAG Call for Projects
 - TA Measure A Local Shuttle Program
 - C/CAG Local Transportation Services Shuttle Program
- Program purpose: provide funding for the operation of local shuttle services
- Eligible costs include operations, marketing & administration of shuttles

Eligibility



- Sponsor must be a public agency
- Serve county residents & employees
- Provide access to regional transit and/or meets local mobility needs
- Open to public & ADA compliant
- Funds are to supplement, not supplant other funding sources
- SamTrans concurrence letter required
- Governing board resolution required



Process

- Joint Call for Projects January 13, 2020
 - FY 2020/21 & 2021/22
 - Up to \$9M from TA Measure A
 - Up to \$1M from C/CAG



Changes from Last Cycle

- Scoring Criteria adjustments
 - Increase "Effectiveness" by 10 points reduce "Readiness" & "Policy Consistency" criteria by 5 points each to maintain 100 point maximum
 - Reduce maximum points available under "Funding Leverage" for shuttles that have failed to meet benchmarks from 18 – 10 points
- Operating cost per passenger benchmarks revised to reflect increase in CPI

	 Shuttle links w/ other fixed route transit (more
	points for higher ridership routes)
	• Improves access from TOD to major activity centers
	 Reduces single occupant vehicle trips

Funding Leverage – Projects Meeting Benchmarks

Evaluation Criteria	Details
Funding Leverage	 Percentage of matching funds contribution: >25% to <50% up to 10 pts 50% to <75% up to 15 pts 75% to <100% up to 18 pts Extra 2 pts for private sector funding



Funding Leverage – Missing Benchmarks by >50%

Evaluation Criteria	Details
Funding Leverage	 Percentage of matching funds contribution: 50% or greater – 5-10 points Extra 2 pts for private sector funding
