

# San Mateo County Shuttle Program Call For Projects

### Program Overview

- Joint TA & C/CAG Call for Projects
  - TA Measure A Local Shuttle Program
  - C/CAG Local Transportation Services Shuttle Program
- Program purpose: provide funding for the operation of local shuttle services
- Eligible costs include operations, marketing & administration of shuttles

## Eligibility



- Sponsor must be a public agency
- Serve county residents & employees
- Provide access to regional transit and/or meets local mobility needs
- Open to public & ADA compliant
- Funds are to supplement, not supplant other funding sources
- SamTrans concurrence letter required
- Governing board resolution required



### Process

- Joint Call for Projects January 13, 2020
  - FY 2020/21 & 2021/22
    - Up to \$9M from TA Measure A
    - Up to \$1M from C/CAG



### **Changes from Last Cycle**

- Scoring Criteria adjustments
  - Increase "Effectiveness" by 10 points reduce "Readiness" & "Policy Consistency" criteria by 5 points each to maintain 100 point maximum
  - Reduce maximum points available under "Funding Leverage" for shuttles that have failed to meet benchmarks from 18 – 10 points
- Operating cost per passenger benchmarks revised to reflect increase in CPI

# **Funding Match**



Operating Cost/Passenger Benchmarks – Updated for ↑ in CPI

Community	\$10/passenger	\$11/passenger
Door to Door	\$20/passenger	\$22/passenger

Shuttle Type	<b>Op. Cost/Passenger FY20/21</b>	Benchmark missed by 50%
	& 21/22 (Current CFP)	or more
Commuter	\$9/passenger	≥\$13.50/passenger
Community	\$11/passenger	≥\$16.50/passenger
Door to Door	\$22/passenger	≥\$33/passenger

New Shuttles – 15%	<ul> <li>Annual passengers/service hour for past 12 months</li> </ul>
	for existing shuttles, or projected if new shuttles
	<ul> <li>Shuttle links w/ other fixed route transit (more</li> </ul>
	points for higher ridership routes)
	• Improves access from TOD to major activity centers
	<ul> <li>Reduces single occupant vehicle trips</li> </ul>
	& vehicle miles traveled



# Funding Leverage – Projects Meeting Benchmarks

<b>Evaluation Criteria</b>	Details
Funding Leverage	<ul> <li>Percentage of matching funds contribution:</li> <li>&gt;25% to &lt;50% up to 10 pts</li> <li>50% to &lt;75% up to 15 pts</li> <li>75% to &lt;100% up to 18 pts</li> <li>Extra 2 pts for private sector funding</li> </ul>



# Funding Leverage – Missing Benchmarks by >50%

<b>Evaluation Criteria</b>	Details
Funding Leverage	<ul> <li>Percentage of matching funds contribution:</li> <li>50% or greater – 5-10 points</li> <li>Extra 2 pts for private sector funding</li> </ul>



# Policy Consistency and Sustainability

<b>Evaluation Criteria</b>	Details
Policy Consistency &	• Shuttle is included in an adopted local,
Sustainability	specific area, county or regional plan
	<ul> <li>Supports jobs &amp; housing</li> </ul>
	growth/economic development
	<ul> <li>Use of clean fuel vehicle(s) for service</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Accommodation for bicycles</li> </ul>
