| Above Moderate Income | 188,130 | 78,950 | 42.6% | 42.0% |

2. RHNA

- More scrutiny of sites
- Fewer available sites
- Higher RHNA

Methodology Committee

Agreements

- **Jobs** - More RHNA to job rich communities
- **Exclusion** – More RHNA to cities with racial/economic exclusion
- **Focus on jobs (20-60%) and high opportunity (30-60%)**
- **Equity** - Equity part of total allocation, not just income allocation
- **Past RHNA** - Do not limit allocations based on past RHNA
- **Divergence index** - Minimal support for Divergence Index
- **Hazards** - High hazard areas a concern, don't use RHNA

Lack of Agreements

- **VMTs** - Minimal support for Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) factors
- **Unincorporated** – Models show too much growth in unincorp

Statutory Goals

1. Increase housing supply and mix of housing types, tenure, and affordability in all cities and counties in an equitable manner
2. Promote infill development and socioeconomic equity, protect environmental and agricultural resources, encourage efficient development patterns, and achieve GHG reduction targets
3. Promote improved intraregional jobs-housing relationship, including balance between low-wage jobs and affordable housing
4. Balance disproportionate household income distributions (more high-income RHNA to lower-income areas and vice-versa)
5. Affirmatively further fair housing
