# Background

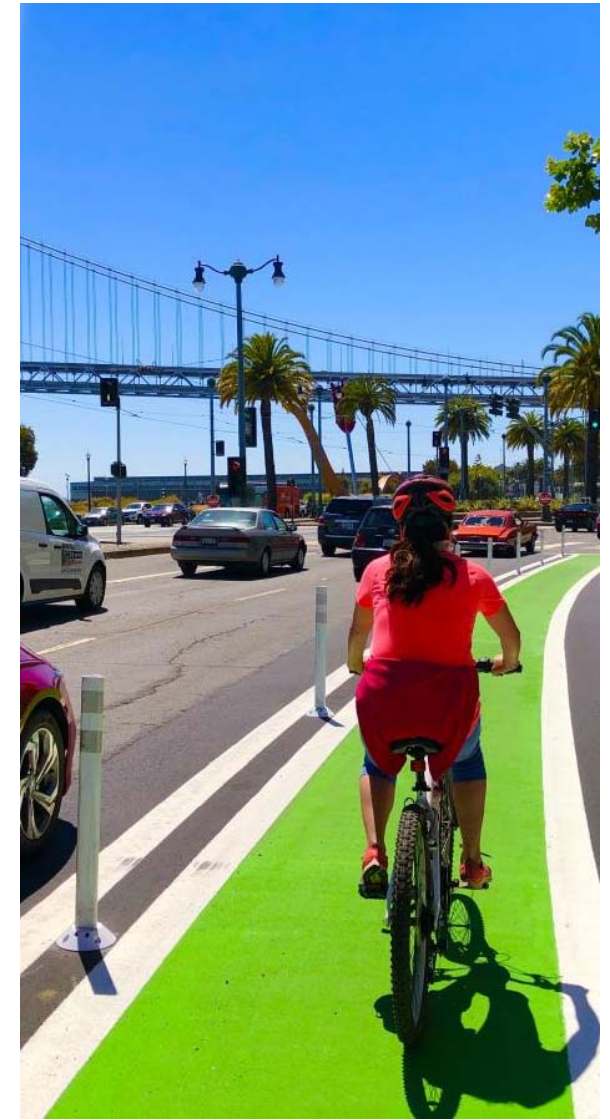
- Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA)
  - \$4 surcharge fee on vehicles registered in the Bay Area
  - TFCA Regional Fund (60%)
  - TFCA Program Manager Fund (40%)



- February 13, 2020 – C/CAG Board approved FY 2020/21 County Program Manager Expenditure Plan, which included funding for innovative projects to be determined

# Limited Call for Projects

- July 24, 2020 – C/CAG released the Limited Call for Projects
- The two project types:
  1. Arterial Traffic Management Projects
    - Advanced transportation technology
  2. Traffic Calming Projects
    - Quick build bicycle and/or pedestrian projects
- Originally estimated \$550,000 available
- Currently \$759,000 available





# Evaluation

- 10 project proposals received on August 21, 2020 deadline
  - 7 traffic calming projects
  - 3 arterial traffic management projects
- Evaluation Panel
  - 3 C/CAG Staff
  - Caltrans District 4 Staff
  - Technical Advisors from MTC and Iteris



## Evaluation Criteria

Cost-effectiveness results (Up to 40 points)

Safety (Up to 20 points)

Project readiness and timely use of funds (Up to 15 points)

Community support (Up to 10 points)

Innovation (Up to 10 points)

Countywide plans/consistency (Up to 5 points)

TFCA Project Vicinity Map



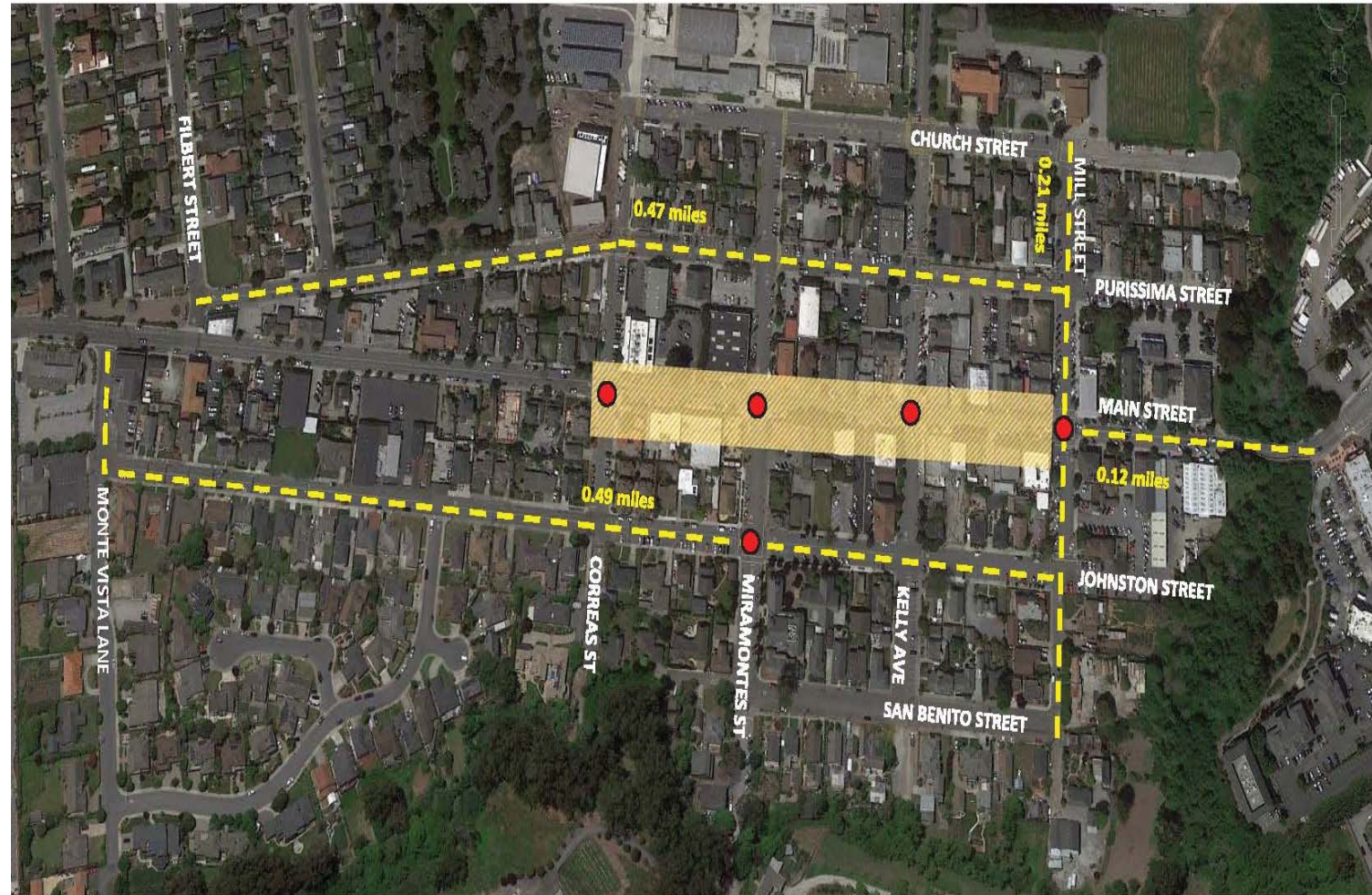

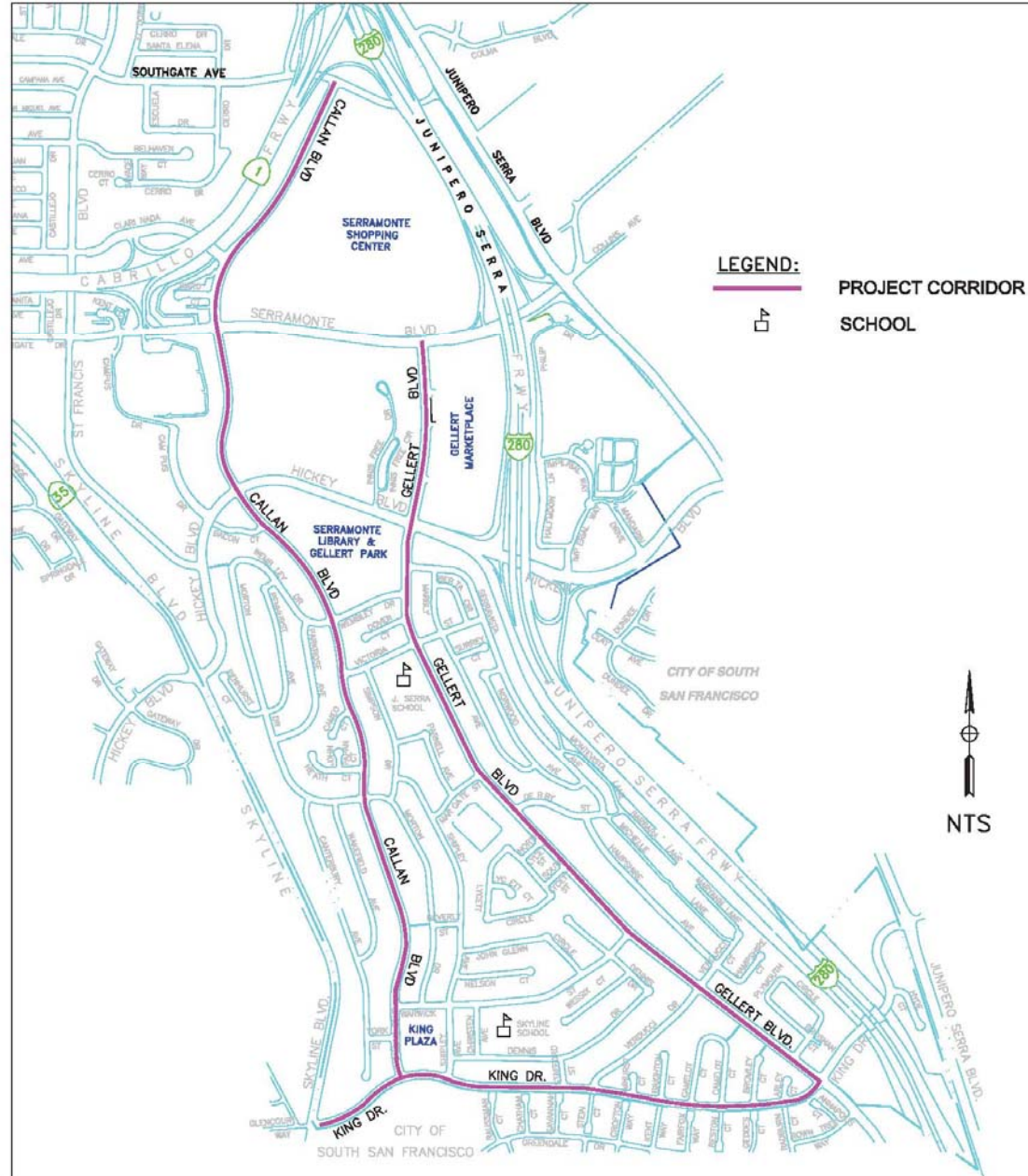
### City of Half Moon Bay—Vicinity Map

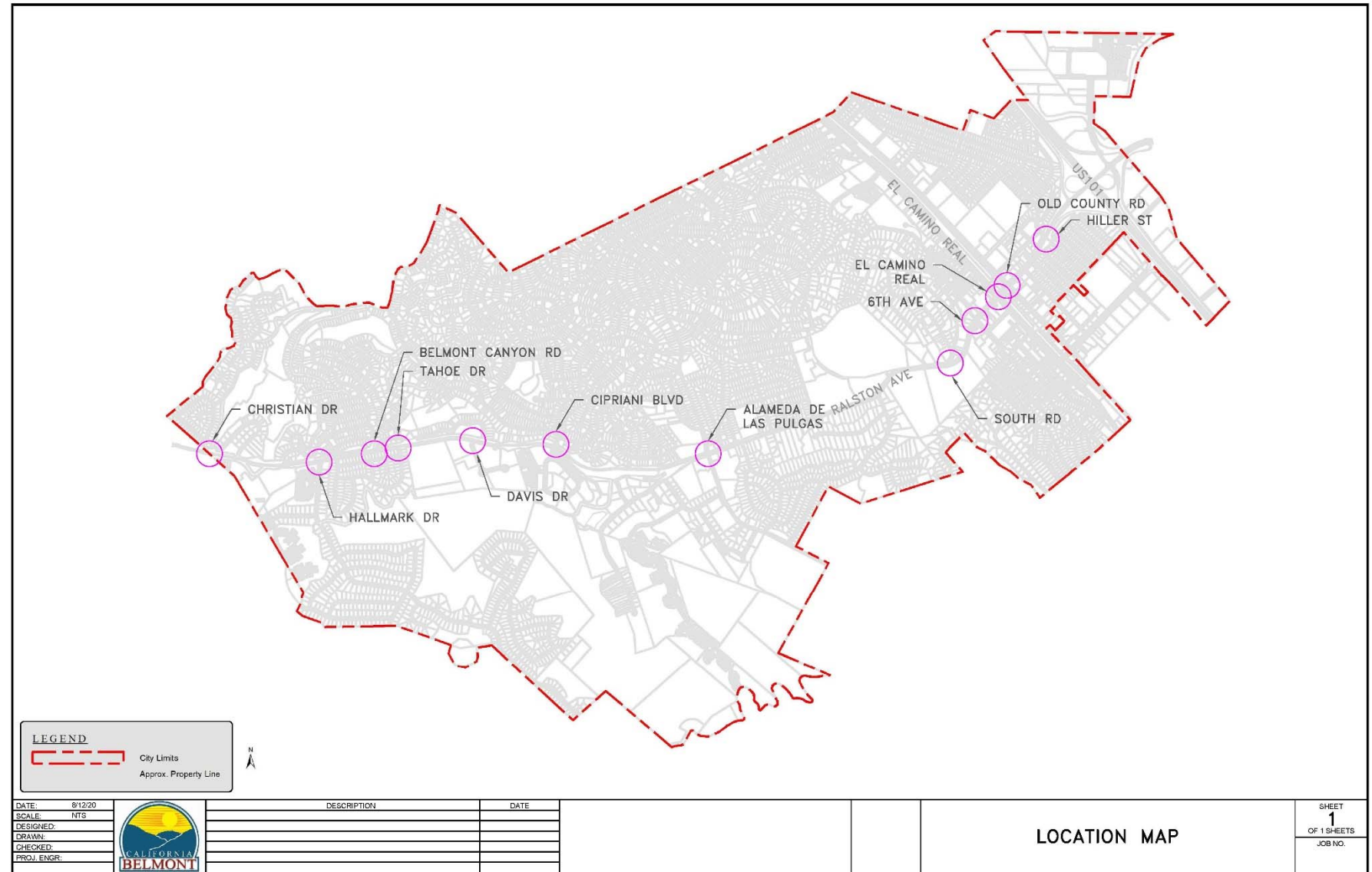
DALY CITY CROSSWALK ENHANCEMENT PROJECT
