### **Call For Applicants Public Member For The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee**

The City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County (C/CAG) currently has five (5) vacant seats on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) available for appointment/reappointment. The BPAC provides advice and recommendations to the C/CAG Board of Directors (Board) on all matters relating to bicycle and pedestrian facilities planning and on the selection of projects for certain state and federal funding.

The vacant seats are for public members. No more than two (2) members, either elected or public, shall reside in the same jurisdiction. The public member must be a resident of one of the Cities listed below.

- Atherton, Belmont, Brisbane, Burlingame, Colma, Daly City, East Palo Alto, Foster City, Half Moon Bay, Hillsborough, Menlo Park, Millbrae, Pacifica, Portola Valley, Redwood City, San Bruno, San Carlos, San Mateo, South San Francisco, or Woodside.

The appointment term is for two years. Members may apply for reappointment at the end of his/her term. The C/CAG BPAC meets on the fourth Thursday of the month at 7:00 p.m. The C/CAG BPAC reserves the right to review applicants and applications at their discretion prior to board appointment.

Appointments for this recruitment will be considered at the May 13, 2021 Board meeting. If there are fewer letters of interests received by the April 23, 2021 deadline than seats vacant, the recruitment will remain open until filled. Appointments may then be recommended at the closest following C/CAG Board meeting.
