California Levine Act Statement

California Government Code Section 84308, commonly referred to as the "Levine Act," prohibits any San Mateo County Express Lanes - JPA (SMCEL-JPA) Board Member from participating in any action related to a contract if he or she receives any political contributions totaling more than \$250 within the previous twelve months, and for three months following the date a final decision concerning the contract has been made, from the person or company awarded the contract. The Levine Act also requires a member of the SMCEL-JPA Board who has received such a contribution to disclose the contribution on the record of the proceeding.
