


Background on MRP 3.0

MRP 3.0 is third iteration of the Municipal Regional Stormwater Permit and coincides with the 30th year anniversary of the San Mateo Countywide Water Pollution Prevention Program

Significantly increased stormwater requirements


- GI retrofit numeric targets
- C.3 thresholds and road requirements
- New monitoring requirements
- Trash controls and monitoring
- Unsheltered homeless populations
- PCBs controls
- Cost reporting
- Asset management
- Additions to "core" provisions (e.g., MS4 mapping & numerous new reporting requirements)

MRP 3.0 Adoption Hearing Outcomes

Essentially, a lot accomplished through reissuance process, not a lot accomplished at the adoption hearing in terms of requested changes

Core issues addressed at the hearing New and Redevelopment

- Road maintenance and reconstruction
- Category C "Special Projects" Affordable Housing
- Green infrastructure retrofit targets

Monitoring

- Overall level of effort and practicality
 <u>Trash</u>
- Timing and tools (source controls/offsets)

PCBs/Mercury Controls

- Acreage/load reduction requirements
- Applicable tools
