AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE CITY/COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS OF SAN MATEO COUNTY AND

KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR SMART CORRIDOR NORTHERN CITIES PS&E AND DESIGN SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County (hereinafter referred to as "C/CAG") and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. (hereinafter referred as "Consultant") are parties an Agreement originally dated January 19, 2022, for Smart Corridor Northern Cities PS&E and Design Support Services (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1, executed on September 1, 2022, adjusted the budgets between Tasks 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 with no cost increase; and

WHEREAS, C/CAG desires to add \$99,000 to the contract with the Consultant to cover additional scope and costs related to the completion of the PS&E package, and addressing and responding to a high volume of stakeholder input; this will result in a contract not-to-exceed amount of \$449,000; and

WHEREAS, C/CAG and Consultant have determined that no time is required to complete the Project, and thus no change to the Agreement schedule is required; and

WHEREAS, C/CAG and Consultant desire to amend the Agreement as set forth herein.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by C/CAG and Consultant that:

1. The scope of work for the Agreement, as provided in Exhibit A, "Scope of Work", shall include the following new Task 8: Additional Services:

"Task 8: Additional Services:

- Daly City video wall research and coordination: Kimley-Horn will assist in evaluating the installation of a Video Wall at Daly City TMC. As part of this task, Kimley-Horn will attend up to two (2) meetings with the City of Daly City to discuss potential improvements.
- Caltrans forms: As part of the encroachment permit review process, Kimley-Horn will complete all additional forms requested by Caltrans. It is anticipated that these forms will include: Utility Certification, Utility Policy Certification, TMP Checklist, Right of Way Data Sheet, Damage Clause Recommendation
- Caltrans encroachment permit submittals and coordination: Kimley-Horn will
 revise the Caltrans encroachment permit up to three (3) times. For each of these
 revisions, Kimley-Horn will attend a comment review meeting with Caltrans to
 discuss comment responses and confirm initial responses will be accepted by
 Caltrans.
- Confirming conductor schedule information: Kimley-Horn will complete
 additional design review for conductor schedules where as-builts are not
 available.
- Evaluation of Intermountain Infrastructure Group (IIG) Submittals: Kimley-Horn will assist C/CAG to evaluate IIG cost proposals for installation of conduit and

- fiber optic cable. In addition, Kimley-Horn will review fiber optic material submittals to confirm proposed fiber optic cable will meet project specifications.
- Post Final Design Package: Kimley-Horn will update the construction documents for the City of Daly City one (1) time after the initial Final design package.
- Construction Quality Management Plan (QMP): Kimley-Horn will create a QMP to be used during the construction phase of the project.
- Caltrans revised standards: Since Caltrans is releasing new standard plans and specifications in 2023, Kimley-Horn will evaluate the revisions between the 2022 and 2023 versions and update the project documents accordingly.

Task 8 Deliverables:

- Caltrans encroachment permit forms
- Three (3) Caltrans encroachment permit PS&E packages
- One (1) Post-Final PS&E packages Construction QMP
- One (1) Revised PS&E package incorporating Caltrans 2023 standards"
- 2. The Project Budget and Schedule of the Agreement as provided in Exhibit B, shall be replaced with a new Exhibit B, "Revised Project Budget and Schedule", attached hereto and incorporated into the Agreement.
- 3. The new Exhibit B, "Revised Project Budget and Schedule" reflects the Consultant's additional scope of work and budget.
- 4. Except as expressly amended herein, all other provisions of the Agreement shall remain full force and effect.
- 5. This amendment shall take effect on May 11, 2023.

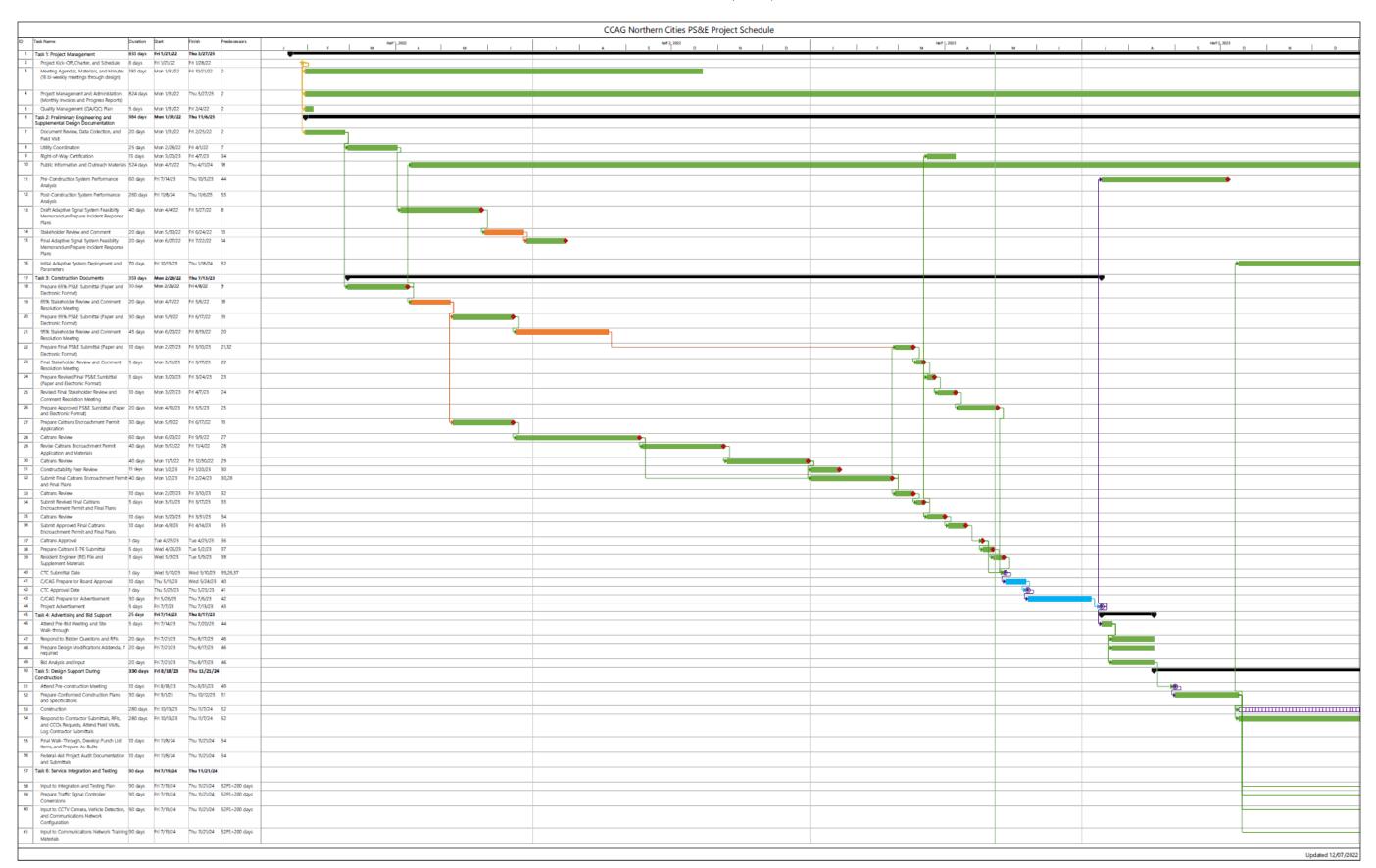
