





























## Grant Prospecting and Collaboration

San Jose Conservation Corps' Development Team assists with identifying funding sources for high need projects and writing the grant proposals to fund the projects.

We facilitate the project development process to build a competitive grant proposal with a clear, compelling narrative.



## California Coastal Conservancy Grant

An open rolling grant program for any kind of outdoor work related to Ocean and Bay access.

- Can cover everything from Restoration projects, invasive species removal, trail and enhance recreational amenities.
- Through collaborating with the San Jose Conservation Corps on a grant such as this, we create a strong grant proposal to complete the work while also offering unique workforce development opportunities for local youth.
- This then creates the workforce to steward these projects and complete others in the future.



## Wildlife Conservation Boards Grant Program

A Multi-Funding Stream Grant Program that distributes funds from Prop 68,1, 84,40,50, the Habitat Conservation Fund, the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund and many other state funding sources.

- Perfect Grant program for any kind of Restoration or urban greening based project.
- Bioswales, Park improvements, fuel reduction projects, public access projects, flood mitigation, and other potential projects.
