
Single Family Home+ Program

This current program provides energy upgrades and resources. To **reduce building energy**


Three main offerings include:

- 1. Rebates for energy efficiency and electrification (no income requirements)
- 2. Contractor network
- 3. No-cost Energy Advisor

Fill gaps in the energy program landscape / reduce the number of programs that provide the same services.




Equity centered






Step 1: Connect with the Comprehensive Concierge Service

Step 2: Develop a Detailed Scope of Work & Cost Estimates

Step 3: Installation

Step 4: (optional): Electrification Upgrades





Step 1: Connect with the Comprehensive Concierge Service

- Call to explore interest and eligibility
- A concierge will provide a home assessment and performance tests

Program Participation

Step 2: Develop a Detailed Scope of Work & Cost Estimates

- Concierge will provide a detailed upgrade and financial plan, if needed
- If recommendations are not covered by BayREN, customer will be referred to other programs

Step 3: Installation

- Work with a vetted, participating contractor to install energy efficiency upgrades focused on weatherization and remediation
 - BayREN funded measures will be installed at no/low-cost to the consumer (depending on income)

Step 4 (optional): Electrification Upgrades

 With the assistance of your concierge, work with thirdparty providers to install electrification upgrades
