Ad-hoc Committee Rosters

- Stormwater Committee has two primary ad-hoc workgroups ullet(3-5 members each – historically, chair/vice chair included):
 - Funding & Finance Workgroup
 - Reconvened in 2021 to support discussions around dedicated stormwater revenue (SB 231, Regional Collaborative, etc.)
 - Meets as needed (approx. 1-4 times annually)
 - Likely more discussion near term given current program funding and increased MRP costs
 - MRP Implementation Workgroup
 - Formed in 2013
 - Meets as needed (approx. 2-4 times annually)
 - Advises on MRP reissuance, ongoing compliance issues and SMCWPPP annual program budget
