Dear Assemblymember Stefani:

On behalf of the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County (C/CAG), I would like to thank you for your efforts on behalf of those who live, work, and play in San Mateo County. We appreciate your work on this year's budget, which we understand is still in its early stages. If the opportunity presents itself and there is budget capacity, we ask that you please consider the following key C/CAG budget requests in your district:

Stormwater Management

1. <u>Colma El Camino Real Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project:</u>

\$3,700,000 to fund partial construction of Segment A of the El Camino Real Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement/Sustainable Streets Project. This segment of the project would span from Albert M Teglia Blvd to Mission Road in the Town of Colma and would transform approximately 1 mile of this currently vehicle-centered state highway into a multi-modal transportation corridor. The project would include buffered bike lanes, continuous sidewalk, improved pedestrian crossings, ADA-compliant curb ramps, enhanced street lighting, landscaping, stormwater treatment measures, and upgraded safe harbor bus stops among other improvements to this regionally important transportation network.
