Overview

SFO is the busiest airport in the Bay Area

Future forecast to accommodate 71.1 million annual passengers based on existing runway layout





What is the Airport Development Plan (ADP)?



What's In the ADP?

- Includes Recommended ADP (subject of environmental review):
 - New boarding area for contact gates at existing terminals
 - Redevelopment Central Hub providing multi modal transportation hub and public/employee parking
 - New consolidated rental car center and on-airport vehicle storage
 - Expansion of electric AirTrain system and maintenance facility
- Accommodate forecast passenger demand with existing airfield and airspace
- No plans for runway expansion
- All SFO projects are funded by SFO and must adhere to federal regulations; no funding from San Mateo county residents


Goals of the ADP

- Continue to modernize SFO
- Enhance passenger experience
- Match boarding area/gates and landside facilities to the capacity of the existing runway capacity

What the ADP Won't Do

- Won't change runway configurations or flight paths
- Won't expand airport property footprint
- Won't increase runway capacity




