

Stormwater Program Announcements

- **C/CAG Board:**
 - December: Received a presentation on Countywide Stormwater Program Update; approved Resolution 25-76 appointing Debbie Rudock, City of Half Moon Bay, for the Coastal Region City/Town seat; Adam Rak, City of San Carlos, for the Central Region City/Town seat; and Marie Chuang, Town of Hillsborough, for the At-Large City/Town seat to the governing board of the San Mateo County Flood and Sea Level Rise Resiliency District (OneShoreline).
 - January: No meeting



Stormwater Program Announcements

- **Annual Reports:**

- Regional Water Board (RWB) staff have completed initial review of the FY24-25 Annual Reports.
- RWB staff may reach out to permittees regarding questions/completeness, etc.
- RWB staff have already reached out to some permittees regarding FY24-25 trash reduction reporting, pertaining to the 100% reduction goal, relative to FY23-24 load reductions and baseline numbers.
- Program staff provided guidance to the relevant permittees to support responding to RWB staff and has also engaged RWB staff on this topic to address any questions directly



Stormwater Program Announcements

- **Stormwater Legislation:**

- SB 682 (Allen) PFAS Regulations – PFAS ban for new product categories, including cleaning products, cookware, dental floss, juvenile products, food packaging, ski wax. Vetoed by Governor in October.
- SB 601 (Allen) Nexus Waters – Would establish new water quality regulations and litigation provisions under the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act for “nexus waters”. Made a two-year bill. Allen has brought the bill back for the second year of the legislative cycle. CASQA is engaged in the development of this bill in its second year.
- AB 1313 (Papan) Statewide Commercial, Industrial and Institutional Permit – The bill did not pass out of the Assembly last year. It was formally withdrawn from consideration early February and was not reintroduced for a second year.



Stormwater Program Announcements

- **MRP 4 Reissuance Process**

- Countywide Programs/Permittees met with Regional Water Board (RWB) staff on February 11 to discuss low priority provisions
 - Identified C.6 as a potential area for additional discussion (Construction Site requirements i.e., inventories, SWPPP approvals, PCBs requirements)
- Future workgroup meetings focused on specific medium and high priority provisions will be scheduled with support from RWB staff, and permittees with an interest in these provisions (e.g., C.3, C.8, C.10, C.11/12) are welcome to participate
- In the coming weeks, C/CAG staff will provide a summary of planned workgroup meetings at the regional scale for San Mateo County Permittees to consider participating in



Stormwater Program Announcements

- **Other Issues / Considerations**

- PCB TMDL Reopener – adopted in 2010 and the current deadline for achieving the prescribed wasteload allocation is 2030. Regional Water Board (RWB) staff will present an informational item on the San Francisco Bay PCB TMDL Revision Strategy at the March 11, 2026 RWB Board meeting outlining the planned approach to revising the PCB TMDL.
- State Water Board Cost Reporting – The State Water Board (SWB) adopted the Policy for the Standardization of Cost Reporting in Municipal Stormwater Permits on January 22, 2025. SWB has developed its online cost reporting portal to collect standardized cost data from permittees and expects to launch the portal in spring 2026. Permittees will need to begin documenting costs for reporting via the State Water Board online portal in FY2026-27.



Stormwater Program Announcements

- **Funding Opportunities:**

- Caltrans Community Cleanup & Employment Pathways Grant – C/CAG was awarded \$501,462 to implement litter abatement and community engagement in up to 11 San Mateo County jurisdictions. Focus on workforce development and community partnerships (San Jose Conservation Corps and Climate Resilient Communities)
- EPA R9 San Francisco Bay Program Office Funds FY25 – EPA Region 9 released a Notice of Funding Opportunity for as much as \$80 million under a competitive grant program seeking to fund projects that will enhance water quality, restoration and monitoring of the San Francisco Bay. \$1-\$5 million range with a 25% local match requirement. Due March 3, 2026.
- Prop 4 (Climate Bond) – Still waiting for updates on the State Water Board plans to release guidelines for stormwater grant program (FY26-27)
