TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT ARTICLE 3 (TDA 3) PROGRAM CALL FOR PROJECTS FY 2026-2028

Responses To Questions At The Applicant Workshop On February 24, 2026

Question 1: If a city/town does not have a Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) or equivalent committee to review the project application, can the application be reviewed by the countywide BPAC and/or receive City Council approval instead?

Answer 1: If a city/town does not have a BPAC or equivalent committee, they can utilize the C/CAG BPAC to review the project. The city/town should not receive Council approval in lieu of BPAC review.

Question 2: Is construction management/support (including professional services required for project oversight, including Resident Engineering, Construction Inspection, Material Testing, and general Contract Administration and Support) an eligible expenditure under TDA 3?

Answer 2: Yes, those construction support activities are eligible.
