Planning and capital projects are required to provide at least a 10% local match in order to be considered for TDA Article 3 grant funds.

For projects located mostly within an MTC EPC or C/CAG EFA with an equity score of 8 or higher, the full amount of points will be awarded when a 10% match is provided. Additional match above 10% in projects located mostly within an EPC or EFA will not increase the score for this criteria.
