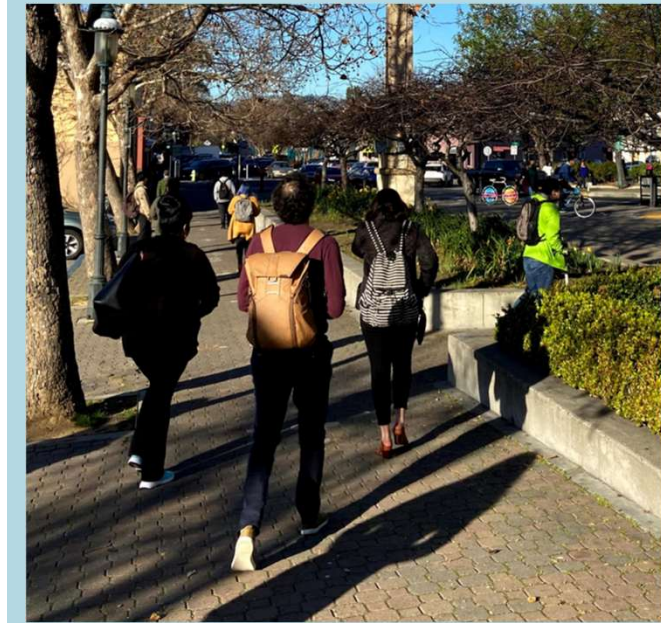

TDA 3: FY 2026-2028

- Three-year cycle
- Available: \$4.7M
 - \$800,000 for planning
 - Remaining \$3.9M for capital
- Maximum planning request: \$200,000
- Maximum capital request: \$750,000
