ADDENDUM NO. 1

C/CAG is issuing addendum No. 1 to the 2026 C/CAG Call for projects to ensure consistency across all applications and provide additional clarification on several items.

Updates are included in the addendum. Where text is revised, it is in red font. Deleted text is shown in strike-through format.

Implications for Applicants

Applicants are encouraged to review the addendum in detail to understand how these changes may affect their proposals.

Application Deadline

The application deadline of June 30, 2026 at 12:00 P.M. remains unchanged.

Project Sponsor and Project Requirements

For each project, sponsors must provide a Complete Streets Checklist for each distinct project location using the Complete Streets web portal (located at complete-streets.mtcanalytics.org). Sponsors are required to ~~submit their Complete Streets Checklist for review and approval~~ **attach a draft of the Checklist to their application when submitting to C/CAG (DO NOT select submit until C/CAG BPAC review and approval)**. CTAs must make checklists available to their Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) for review prior to project nomination. For projects that have already submitted a Complete Streets checklist for prior cycles of regional discretionary funding, sponsors may be required to complete an updated checklist or complete a second checklist review with their BPAC, as determined on a case-by-case basis by MTC staff.

Updated 2026 C/CAG Call for Projects Application Materials:

- The 2026 C/CAG Call for Projects Application has been updated with the following revisions.
 - Page 1, 'Project Location' Field: the form field has been reformatted for improved usability
 - Page 3, 'Letters of Support' Field: the form field has been reformatted for improved usability
 - Page 5, 'Project Funding' field: Formulas associated with the funding summary table have been updated to improve calculation functionality and consistency. The cells impacted include the 'Total OBAG 4 Request', 'Total CARE TA Request', 'Total

TFCA Request’, and ‘Totals’ cells.

MTC Community Action Resource & Empowerment (CARE) Technical Assistance:
