The San Mateo County Transportation Authority (**SMCTA**) is pleased to announce a [Call for Projects \(CFP\) for both the Cycle 8 Pedestrian and Bicycle \(Ped/Bike\) and Cycle 4 Transportation Demand Management \(TDM\) Programs.](#)

The Joint CFP has officially been released today, Monday, August 31st. This year, **approximately \$24.7 million in Measure A and W Ped/Bike Program funding** and **\$3 million in TDM funding** will be made available. Applications will be due by **October 30, 2026**, with awards expected to be adopted at the SMCTA's January board meeting.

This year, SMCTA is proud to announce the launch of our [new grant-management platform and Call for Projects web tool.](#) All applications will be submitted via the new platform, hosted by Euna Grants. Applicants will have access to the CFP web tool to evaluate project competitiveness based on program metrics and will use the tool's output in their submitted application.

SMCTA will host a virtual workshop on September 14, 2026, from 3:00-4:30 p.m.
